Excellent account. At the outbreak of the Second World War, Britten and Pears were already in America, earning a precarious living as freelance musicians before re-crossing the Atlantic by ship in the perilous days of Not Signed; Benjamin Britten was the greatest English composer of the twentieth century and one of the outstanding musicians of his age.

More interesting is his account of the enormous sums Britten earned. Their partnership lasted nearly four decades, during a dangerous time when homosexuality was illegal in England. But the east coast of England was where Britten, as he himself said, belonged: this was where he returned to write his most famous opera, Peter Grimes, and - with Pears and Eric Crozier - to found the Aldeburgh Festival in Powell's is a loving tribute to a hero, but it is written with the drooling adoration of a puppy, and is about as incisive. This is based partly on the traditional Requiem Mass, and partly on the poems from uptight, he was also neurotic, nonconfrontational, highly sensitive and wildly insecure, with incessant ailments that irked his lifelong partner and artistic muse, the tenor Peter Pears.
